This year based on parent feedback we started a 'Homework Club' during after school care. This operates like an extra-curricular activity, where parents need to sign their children up to participate on a daily basis. Parents are responsible for packing their child/ren's homework. Educators will not be tutoring children, but supervising them to complete their homework.

Important changes to CCMS/CCB

From 2 July 2018 the Government will be introducing a new child care package called the Child Care Subsidy, which will replace the current Child Care Benefit & Child Care Rebate. These changes will affect many families that use our service.

Three elements will determine the level of subsidy a family will receive:

1. Combined family income
2. Activity level of parents
3. Type of child care service.

LAC Frequently Asked Questions

How does the waitlist work?

We are fully booked for after school care Monday – Friday. If you require additional care you will need to be added to the waitlist. As families cancel their bookings we offer places off the waitlist. Places are offered in accordance with Priority of Access guidelines.

What do I do if I want to cancel my bookings?

If you would like to cancel any permanent bookings you need to notify the Director in writing before the first day of term. All bookings current on the first day of each term are booked and payable for the entire term.

How do I pay my invoice? And how is it distributed?

The centre now emails out invoices through our online enrolment system 'Hubworks'. Invoices will be emailed out in Week 7. Payments are accepted over the phone or in centre. You can pay by either visa, mastercard, debit, cheque or cash. If you would like to pay in instalments throughout the term you can approach the centre Director who will set up a payment plan for your family.

How much food do my children get at LAC?

LAC provides breakfast during before school care from 7:15am-8:40am. Children have the option of a variety of different cereals, yoghurt, toast, raisin toast as well as a variety of special options that change each day.

During the afternoon children are given a first afternoon tea at 3:15pm which includes a large fruit platter and a substantial snack which changes daily. At 5pm children are given a second snack which is cooked by Educators and children. Our daily menu is on display outside on the blackboard as well as on the whiteboard inside.

What activities do we offer?

LAC operates off the principle of 'free play' and follows a play based syllabus. However we also provide structured activities for children to participate in on a daily basis. These can include homework club, robotics, cooking, group activities, craft and Kindergarten room activities. These are structured around a particular weekly theme that is displayed on our display board.
